It is important that the planner is brought to school every day. For reading rewards, children will receive daily stamps when an adult logs their reading at home by ticking the relevant day in the planner. Parents can also use the comments section of the planner for any notes or feedback.

Finally, I'd like to extend a personal thank you to our fantastic team of teachers and support staff. Their hard work and dedication have been central to making these first weeks such a success. I am confident that, with such a strong start, we are set for a wonderful year ahead.
