Dear Parents and Guardians,

YEAR 3 & YEAR 4 END OF DAY DISMISSAL

I would like to kindly remind you not to walk through the lines when children are walking to their lining up place for end-of-day dismissal. While I understand that this may be the quickest route, it poses a safeguarding risk and can cause unnecessary confusion during this important transition time.

To ensure the safety and smooth dismissal of all our pupils, we ask that you please wait and allow the children to reach their lining up space for staff to dismiss the children in an orderly and safe manner.

As a leadership team we will be monitoring this over the next two weeks and deciding if further steps need to be taken to ensure the safety of our children.

Should we not see an improvement I will have no choice but to keep the school gates locked until 15:15 – thus allowing for the children to exit the building first. Your cooperation is crucial in maintaining a secure environment for the children.

FLU JAB

This autumn school term, your child is being offered a flu vaccination through a nasal spray or injection. This year the vaccination is being offered in school to all children from Reception to Year 6 as part of a national health campaign to protect vulnerable people, including young children, from flu this Autumn and Winter.

The flu jab is through Locala, we will be sending the form out to all parents and guardians electronically next week.

Please note **the nasal spray contains gelatine/porcine**, therefore if your child is a **practising Muslim** or from the **Jewish faith** please tick **'injection'** on the form when completing. If you are not sure – please see me, Mr Rollin or Mrs Aslam.

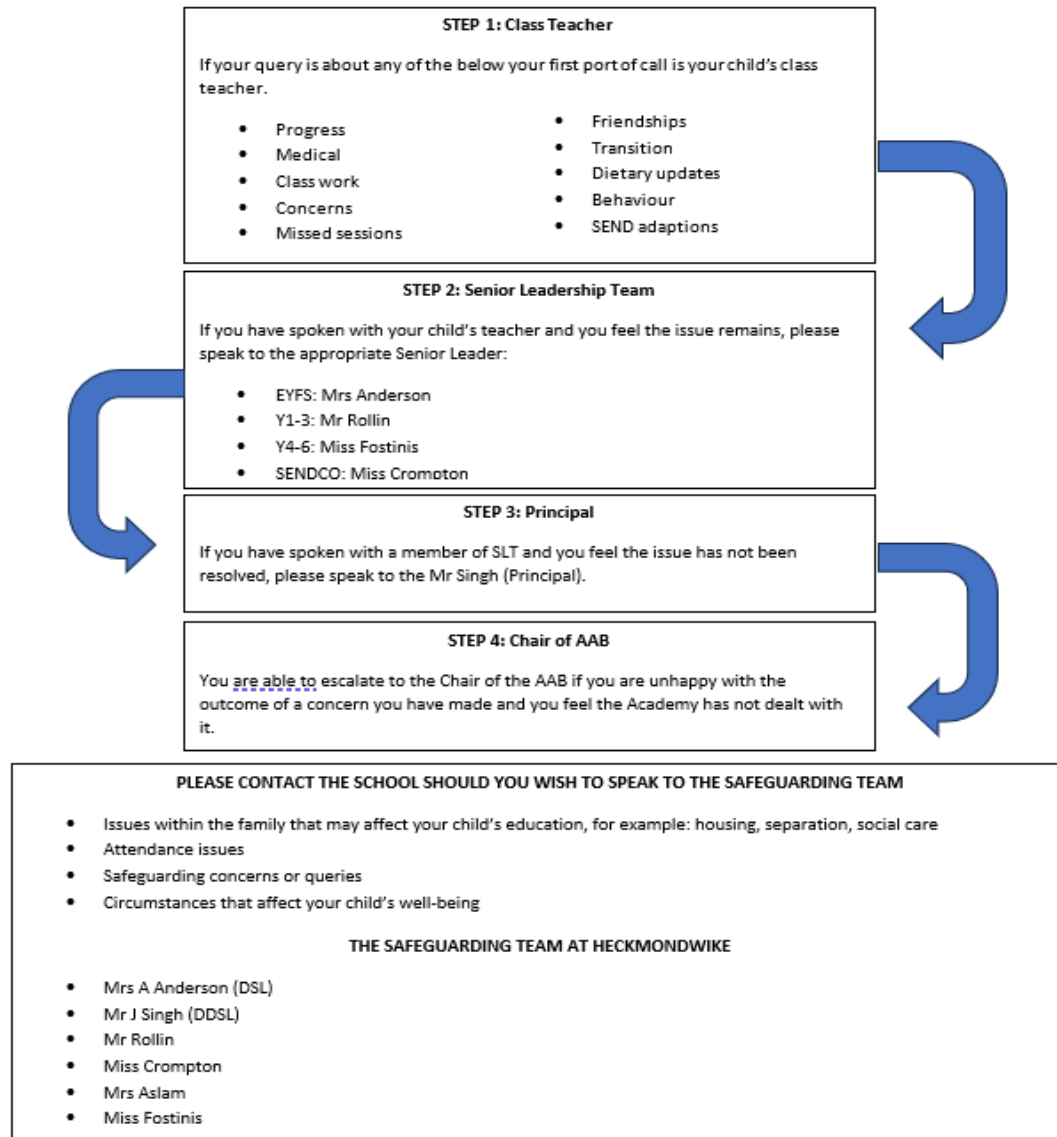
